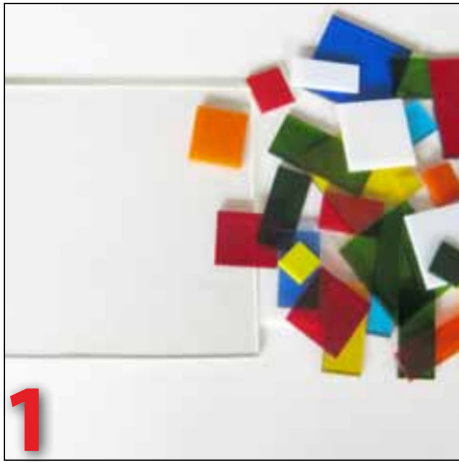


Retro Squares ▪ Decorative tile

Glass Cutting: **Simple straight lines**

Firing: **Full fuse**

Stacks of squares and rectangles create softer concentric shapes when full fused.



1 Cut various sized squares and rectangles from an assortment of transparent and/or opal colors. Don't worry about accuracy — quirky shapes are part of the appeal.



2 Place the largest shapes on the Base in a pattern you like, using a pinpoint of glue to secure. Fill gaps larger than 1/4" but don't worry about smaller gaps. Affix smaller shapes on top of larger ones, and still smaller ones on top of those. (For best results, no more than 4 per stack.)



3 Full Fuse.

Materials We Used

Base: 8-inch Clear Square

Glass Colors: assorted Transparent and Opal palette.

Tips & Tricks

Contrasting color choices make a more dramatic design. Keep in mind that transparent glass colors allow the color below to show through, so plan accordingly — and use this to your advantage!
